## Parkview Junior League

## 2022-2023 Rules

- 1. Schedule: This is a 28 week Scheduled league. Bowling starts on September  $9^{th}$ , 2022 and finishes on April  $8^{th}$  2023.
- 2. Position Round: Position rounds will be weeks 10, 20, and 28 starting on lanes 3&4, 5&6, and 7&8. The last week of bowling is the final position round for final standings.
- 3. Handicap: Handicap is 90% of 180. Bowlers will establish with the first 3 games bowled.
- 4. Sanctioned League: Sanction fees are \$4.00 to USBC (paid for by the local association) And \$2.00 to our league prize fund. due the first week that you bowl.
- 5. Bowling Fee: The cost of bowling has not gone up this year, so it remains at \$5.00 per week.
- 6. Secretary/Treasurer Fees: \$5.00 per week for a total of \$140.00.
- 7. Age Requirements: A child may start bowling at the age that they can throw the ball down the lane unassisted. They cannot be 18 until after August 1, 2022.
- 8. Scoring: 3 games will be bowled each session with a total of 4 points being awarded. A team will win one point for each team handicap game won and one point for team handicap series won.
- 9. Time Fouls: A lack of readiness for bowling will result in a first-time offense of a verbal warning, and all following offenses will result in a zero for the frame. They are only allowable excuse is if you need to use the restroom.
- 10. Banquet: The banquet will be held on April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2023.
- 11. Bowing Money: Team captains are responsible for collecting money, marking the envelopes, and giving it to the treasurer. If there is an error, the treasurer shall return the envelope for corrections to the team captain. No bowler may charge without first getting permission from the secretary/treasurer, or the president.
- 12. Dress Code: No clothing is to be worn that promotes Alcohol, Tobacco, or Sexual Content.

1st offense: you will be asked to turn the article of clothing inside out.

2ne and all following offenses: you will be asked to leave and not be allowed to bowl that day

13. Language: the use of foul language will not be tolerated. Immediate dismissal for the week may occur.

- 14. Bullying and Intimidation: Engaging in improper tactics or conduct in connection with bowling including, but not limited to, physical or verbal abuse toward other persons. Please keep your comments, hands, feet, and body gestures to yourself. If you engage in such activities, you will be given one warning then will be asked to leave upon any further activity of this type.
- 15. Sportsmanship: If you feel the need to walk away or leave the bowling center for any reason other than an emergency (as decided by the league supervisor? Then you will not use your average minus 10 pins. You will receive a zero for every frame that you miss. Be considerate and think of your teammates.
- 16. Parent/child Tournament: The date for the 2022-2023 is set for April 15<sup>th</sup> 2023. The tournament is for the Parkview juniors USBC youth bowlers and their parents. If a parent cannot bowl then a friend/relative may fill in with the approval of one of the league officers.
- 17. Team Tables: Teams bowling on odd numbered lanes will sit at the front tables and the teams bowling on even numbered lanes will sit at the back tables.
- 18. Electronics: No one that is bowling is allowed to play on any electronic device during league play.
- 19. Bowling Etiquette: Bowling etiquette will be enforced.
