Parkview Juniors Bowling League Rules 2024-2025

- 1.) This is a 28-week scheduled league; with a start date of September 7^{th,} 2024 & ending day of April 5^{th,} 2025 (TBD by tournament days & snow days) (Bowling Practice starts at 9:20am, 9:30am is when bowling starts! SHARP!) NO EXCEPTIONS. We are on a time limit! If you show up late you will receive zeros for the frames you have missed without a chance to make it up. Days off will be 11/30/2024 & 12/28/2024
- 2.) One parent must be present at each table. NO EXCEPTIONS! (work that out amongst yourselves and team). Please clean up your table after you are done bowling and put chairs back (5 to a table), and return house balls to the bowling racks.
- 3.) Post bowling is NOT allowed. You are only allowed to pre-bowl as follows; you must pay the league fee for that child, put it in an envelope with the team's name, and child's name and the date you bowl. If that is not done, your child's scores will not be counted and you will be charged full price of the bowling alley. No Pre-bowling on Friday evenings after 8pm. It's best to call ahead first.
- **4.)** We are only allowing to **pay 4 weeks in advance** at one time per child; unless you are paying for the rest of the season, at one time. Anything over 4 weeks of payment (\$28 per child) will be returned to you. (Make checks payable to PVJR; Parkview Juniors) (Players must participate for 25 weeks in order to get a league ball).
- 5.) Age requirements: a child may start bowling at age 5 (they must be 5 by August 1st, 2024) and cannot be older than 18yrs (as of August 1st, 2024).
- 6.) Position Rounds will be weeks 10, 20 & 28. The last week of bowling will be a position round for the final standings of the league.
- 7.) Handicap is 90% of 180. Handicaps will be established the after three first 3 games have been bowled.
- 8.) Sanctioned League fees will be paid for the local association, Bowling fees are \$7.00 per child, per week. You can only bowl 4 weeks without paying or your child will not bowl. Lineage fee went up 10 cents, being \$1.25 per game.
- 9.) Scoring: 3 games will be bowled each week with a total of 4 points being award. A team will win one point for each team handicap game won and a point for the team handicap series won.
- 10.) Each team will have a team captain. They are responsible for taking score on the score cards provided. If you don't know how, ask we will teach you how.
- 11.) Each table will be provided a money card. This will be used for weekly bowling fees (preferably to be filled out by the parent) (when filling out the money card please only use black or blue ink, NO PENCILS! The top ½ of the card is for parents, DO NOT write in the bottom half of the card).

- 12.) Team tables: Teams bowling on odd numbered lanes (1,3,5,7,9) will sit at the front of the tables and the teams bowling on the even numbered lanes (2,4,6,8,10) will sit at the back tables.
- 13.) Dress code: No clothing is to be worn that promotes alcohol, tobacco, or sexual content.
- 14.) The use of foul language will NOT be tolerated. Bullying will NOT be tolerated. Keep your comments, hands, feet and body gestures to yourself. Treat others how you want to be treated. You will be asked to leave the premises and be given zeros for the remaining frames left and allowed to return back to bowling the following week.
- 15.) Sportsmanship-Fair and generous behavior or treatment of others, especially in a sports contest. If your child feels the need to walk away or leave the bowling alley for any reason other than an emergency or bathroom break, you will receive a zero for every frame you miss; with a 10-minute grace period. Remember we are here to bowl (time limit) please be considerate and think of your team mates. If you must leave let your president or secretary know.
- 16.) Electronics: No one that is bowling is allowed to play on their cellphones during league time. Again, we are here to bowl and are on a scheduled time limit. There will be baskets provided on all the tables this year for cell phones to be in. If a child is caught on the phone and not paying attention to their turn to bowl, they will receive a zero for that frame. NO PHONES while bowling PLEASE!
- 17.) Bowling Etiquette will be enforced.
- **18.)** Parent/Child Tournament is set for April 12th, 2025 (subject to change) & City Tournament when I know you will know. It will be in March. We will not bowl that week, unless you participate.
- 19.) Bowling Banquette is set for April 19th, 2025 (subject to change)
- 20.) Secretary/Treasurer Fee is \$280.00 for the season.
